NOMINATION CRITERIA

Two broad dimensions are used to evaluate all nominees:

1. Achievements

Entry into the Hall of Fame is granted to those who have achieved extraordinary performance and results as demonstrated by:

- * Medals / Championships
- * Noteworthy Statistics
- * Provincial, National and/ or International participation/results
- * Other category unique elements (see below)

2. Connection to Burnaby

Nominees must be connected to the City of Burnaby in one or more ways: Grew up in Burnaby, Live(d) in Burnaby, Acquired/ Honed their skills in Burnaby, Achievements were with a Burnaby based team/club / school.

NOMINATION CATEGORIES

ATHLETE

Individual career achievements in one or more sports.

COACH

Displays longevity, innovation, legacy, and results.

BUILDER

Shows initiative, longevity, legacy, and results. A builder can be defined as a founder, administrator, referee, official, trainer or volunteer.

TEAM

Team achievements in a single season or across multiple seasons

Please complete the nomination forms as thoroughly as possible, with supporting documents, newspaper clippings, certificates of achievement, photographs, etc.. Submit your nomination by **Thursday November 30th, 2023**.

All nomination forms and accompanying documents will remain the property of the Burnaby Sports Hall of Fame committee. Mail, deliver, or email the original form.

Voting on all nominations received will take place shortly after the deadline date and the successful inductees will be notified soon thereafter. The names of the inductees will also be published in the media.
